Five* scholarships will be awarded to deserving 2nd or 3rd year law school students who intend to practice Indian Law in Oklahoma.

*Two awards of \$2,500.00 and three awards of \$1,000.00.

Applications must include:

- Cover Letter describing commitment to practice Indian Law in Oklahoma;
- 2. Resume describing Indian Law related activities;
- 3. Law school transcript; and
- 4. Academic professional reference letter of support for your application.

G. William "Bill" Rice was an attorney,
University of Tulsa Law School
professor, widely hailed expert on
American Indian legal matters, and
beloved mentor, colleague, and
friend to many. A citizen of the
United Keetoowah Band of Cherokee
Indians, Bill dedicated his life to
furthering the rights of Indigenous
peoples worldwide. This scholarship
is granted in his name and is intended
to help law students with the costs of
the bar exam.
