

## Now Hiring OKLAHOMA MOCK TRIAL COORDINATOR

The Oklahoma High School Mock Trial program helps students in grades 9-12 develop public speaking skills, encourages deductive and inductive reasoning, sharpens reading comprehension, stimulates interest in governmental studies and increases appreciation for our judicial system as a means of enforcing society's laws.

You could be the next driving force behind a dynamic statewide program that brings the courtroom to life for high school students. If you are passionate about empowering students, fostering teamwork and celebrating the art of persuasion, submit your resume for the role of Oklahoma High School Mock Trial coordinator. Lawyers and nonlawyers are welcome to apply.

In this role, you'll have the opportunity to:

- **BE THE VOICE OF MOCK TRIAL:** Serve as the public face of the Oklahoma High School Mock Trial program and connect with students, educators and legal professionals across the state. The coordinator will recruit all Oklahoma schools to participate in the program.
- LEAD WITH CREATIVITY AND ORGANIZATION: Craft the annual program calendar, create compelling promotional materials in conjunction with the OBA Communications Department and orchestrate the entire trial season – from the opening rounds to the Mock Trial Championship. The coordinator is also responsible for program logistics, including correspondence, forms, mailings, evaluations, awards, etc.
- **COLLABORATE AND INSPIRE:** Work hand-in-hand with the OBA Mock Trial Committee, county bar associations and schools statewide to recruit, mentor and guide participants.
- SHAPE THE FUTURE OF ADVOCACY: Oversee the drafting and editing of the case and help review and revise the
  rules. The coordinator will also register and communicate with all teams throughout the season and support students and
  teachers with issues that arise during the competition.
- **CHAMPION EXCELLENCE:** Manage communications, coordinate national competition logistics and prepare and submit the grant to the Oklahoma Bar Foundation keeping the program thriving year after year.
- **CONNECT WITH A NATIONAL NETWORK:** Serve as an official member of the National Mock Trial Association on matters of competition and engage with other coordinators nationwide. The state coordinators meet once a month via Zoom to share ideas, concerns and training opportunities.
